Due to State guidelines for Phase III operations following the Covid -19, Individual and Family passes will not be sold.

Passes will be sold for one and a half hour time slots

Registration for Medford Residents: Online beginning Monday's at 9:00am at medfordrecreation.org or by calling (781) 393-2486 from 9am-3pm Monday-Sunday.

Adult (18 or older): R \$2 / NR \$4

Child (over age 4): R \$1 / NR \$2

Child (under age 4): Free

Senior (62 or older): R \$1 / NR \$2

Daily Pass Fees: * R= Resident. NR = Non-Resident

To allow for social distancing, only 40 passes will be allowed for each time block. Individual passes will be sold for each time block.

To help make time blocks accessible to everyone, passes will go on sale for the following dates for the time indicated:

Res: 7/27: for 8/3 to 8/9

Res: 8/3: 8/5 for 8/10-8/16

Res: 8/10: 8/12 for 8/17-8/23

Per State guidelines, the following restrictions for the 2020 Season will be in effect:

1. Staff, visitors, and patrons must wear a face covering at all times except for when in the water.
2. 6 foot sections and one way directions will be marked on the pool deck to assist maintaining social distancing.
3. While in the water, patrons must maintain 6 foot distance between members outside of their household.
4. Locker rooms will be closed. Only the individual handicap bathrooms will be open. Please come to the pool in your bathing suit.
5. Shower use will be limited to one shower on the pool deck.
6. Swim lessons and camps will not be scheduled this year.
7. Pool will be closed on Monday's for required weekly chemical treatment (shocking).
8. Floatation equipment will be limited to Coast Guard Approved lifejackets only. Equipment brought from home including noodles and toys will not be allowed.
9. Picnic tables cannot be shared by members outside your household. They will be sanitized between swim block times.

Swim Block Times (Tu-Sun)

12:30-2:00pm OR 3:00-4:30pm OR 5:30-7:00pm

*Pool is closed between swim times along with before operational hours for cleaning and frequent sanitation as required by the state.

*Pool is closed on Monday's for weekly high increase of chlorine (shocking the pool) as required by the state.
