

Frequently Asked Questions:

- 1. When can I play?** The courts will open to the public beginning Tuesday, October 20th. You can play anytime from dusk to dawn in small groups (less than 4 people) if no one is using the court. You must stop play if someone comes in with a permit from the Recreation Department.
- 2. Can I request a permit to play?** Anyone can reserve a court.
Step 1: Create a Household Account on [MedfordRecreation.org](https://www.MedfordRecreation.org)
Step 2: Log into your account and click on the [Bocce Court Facility Page](#)
Step 3: Click on the “Request” button below the Google Map.
Step 4: Submit your request. The Recreation Department will review the request and send you a permit if the space is available. Please submit requests 24 hours in advanced so the department has time to review.
- 3. When am I required to have a permit?** Large groups (over 4 people), organizations, or tournaments is required to have a permit. Requests can be made through the Recreation Department.
- 4. Do you provide bocce balls?** You can borrow bocce balls from the Senior Center during operational hours.
- 5. Will you offer lessons?** The Recreation Department will be offering a FREE lessons on November 4th from 10:00am-11:30am. Please call the Recreation Department to register. We plan to offer more lessons and programs this Spring.



Bocce Court Rules

- Courts are open from dawn to dusk.
- Please restrict play for no more than four hours.
- Courts are to be used for individual or small groups (four or less) for play. Organizations, tournaments, and large groups must receive a permit from the Medford Recreation Department.
- No consumption of alcohol allowed.
- No profanity or foul language.
- No loud music.
