POSITION: Lifeguard

DEPARTMENT: Recreation

HOURS OF WORK: This is a seasonal position that begins mid-June to the end of August. Bath House Attendants are scheduled up to 35 hours per week. This position is not eligible for overtime pay. Employees will be expected to work late evenings and weekends.

RATE OF PAY: \$18.00 – \$21.00 per hour.

JOB RESPONSIBILITIES: A Lifeguard is responsible to ensure the safety of all patrons visiting Wright's Pond or Tufts Pool and to respond to emergencies.

- Scans the area of surveillance to make sure that patrons are safe and behaving according to the rules.
- Acts in emergency situations and provides rescue and first aid assistance up to his or her training level until medical personnel arrive and take over.
- Inspects the aquatic facility for unsafe conditions and cleanliness to prevent accidents and reports any hazards to the supervisor.
- Enforces rules consistently and fairly.
- Fills out reports for incidents or other records for reference.

- Age 16 or older
- American Red Cross Lifeguard
- Standard First Aid
- CPR/AED for the Professional Rescuer
- American Red Cross Waterfront Certification preferred
