Parks Commission

Description: Hormel Stadium is a turf field, lined for soccer, football, and lacrosse. Surrounding the field is an eight lane track. The stadium has Home and Visiting Team locker rooms, bath-rooms, Officials Room, and a press box to operate the scoreboard and sound system.
